- 5) Port






Figure 5: Coastal management areas.




Figure 6: Wahi Stream to Pariokariwa Point.and Parininihi.




Figure 7: Mimi Estuary.




Figure 11: Port Taranaki.




Figure 12: Ngā Motu/Sugar Loaf Islands Marine Protected Area and Tapuae Marine Reserve.




Figure 15: Sandy Bay.




Figure 17: Tangahoe Estuary and Manawapou Estuary.
