3.1 Resource Consent Conditions

Condition 28 and Condition 18 (Air discharge)

- The consent holder shall prepare a Site Exit Plan which details how the site is going to be reinstated prior to the consent expiring or being surrendered. The Plan shall be submitted for approval to the TRC at least 6 months prior to this consent expiring or being surrendered.
- The site Exit Plan shall address, but not necessarily be limited to, the following matters:
- How the site will be reinstated so that no raw materials listed or approved under condition 2 of this consent remain on site
- How the site will be reinstated so that no partially decomposed material remains on site
- How nay remaining leachate or sludge, resulting from the operation, will be either removed from the site, buried, treated or otherwise to avoid any adverse effects on groundwater or surface waterThe remediation of irrigated soils and groundwater
- Timeframes for undertaking the activities identified in association with a to c above

Condition 29 and condition 19 (Air discharge)

- The consent holder shall reinstate the site in accordance with the plan approved under condition 28 above prior to this consent expiring or being surrendered.
