Overall we support the consent sought by Opunake Power Ltd provided the recommendations below are taken into consideration and there are no detrimental impacts on the Waiaua awa.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the application and for the opportunity to speak to our submmission.

5. My submission is (give details):

1. In relation to the amount of water that is to be fed into or out of the Opunake Lake, we seek that minimum and maximum levels are stated as a condition. Minimum and maximum water levels will ensure that the Lake is not emptied where there could be impacts on bird and fish species and ensure that high levels do not cause flooding.

2. We ask that any outfall directed to the Opunake Beach be diverted directly out to sea and not left to meander across the beach sideways where people swim.

3. In reference to the reeds and flaxes that are to be removed from the side of the Opunake Lake we request that this only occurs if they stop or hinder the flow of water into the Lake. We also ask that the removal of any reeds and flaxes have minimal impact on native bird and fish species.

4. We note that impacts on cultural values have not been assessed. We ask that this is undertaken prior to consent being granted and the applicant meets with lwi to discuss any concerns they may have.
