Hearing Procedure

While the procedure for the hearing is ultimately determined by the chairperson the Resource Management Act states that:

- a) unnecessary formality is to be avoided;
- b) only members of the hearing panel may question any party or witness
- c) cross-examination is not allowed.

Hearing information

- Expert evidence is not to be read verbatim at the hearing but may be summarised in a "highlights package".
- Non-expert evidence - original submissions lodged on the applications are not to be read verbatim at the hearing but may be expanded on. The Commissioners will read all submissions prior to the commencement of the hearing.
- 15 hard copies of any written information presented by non-expert speakers or their representatives (who are not expert witnesses) shall be made available to the Senior Consents Administration prior to the commencement of the hearing (or as soon as available after your arrival)
- The Council will send you a copy of the agenda before the hearing.
- Tea/Coffee and a light lunch will be provided.
