Conditions for Exhibitors

- You will need to register your interest and work with our Events Facilitator to book your area.

 Please indicate the approximate size of your site on the booking form. Certain areas will be set up and reserved for specific activities, for example, entertainers, children's art area, food stall or stage depending on the venue. You will be advised of set up times closer to the date of the fair.
- Each person is responsible for setting up their site at a reasonable distance from their neighbour. Exhibitors must provide all props and materials required.
- Performing artists are asked to respect the space and quiet ambience of other artists, to avoid any sound conflicts.
- Sites should be completely set up and ready to operate by 8.30am and maintain operation until 3pm to comply with advertising material, unless otherwise advised.
- The Council is not responsible for any loss or damage to your property.
- The Council requires exhibitors selling food and drink to use only reusable, recyclable or compostable containers for their products. Please discuss with the Events Facilitator.
- All food vendors need to comply with relevant health regulations.
- The Council reserves the right to decline vendors or stallholders.
- There will be no offensive material in the garden, but a concept of art in all forms will be borne in mind.
- The Council will be responsible for all advertising and promotion at the Council's cost.
