Your options are not specific enough. To be more precise, I think the Yarrow Stadium stands should be repaired to the required standard, but no more money spent than required to do that.

I am involved in local club cricket, holding administration positions in the New Plymouth Old Boys' cricket club. I am a life member of the club. I am concerned at the lack of money that is made available to all sports other than rugby, and believe even less will be available if most of these stadium proposals go ahead.

It too often seems that what rugby wants from local body organisations, rugby gets. I point out that rugby participation rates are falling. The sport itself is concerned.

We should not be building big facilities for rugby and ignoring the thousands of other young sportsmen and sportswomen in the province who play other sports and struggle for money and facilities. TRC and NPDC need to be more equitable in their funding to all sports. Rugby has the highest profile in New Zealand, but many more people play other sports than the number that play rugby. The Taranaki Rugby Union are more concerned with their status in Taranaki than they are with their own clubs and club competitions. Club sportsmen and sportswomen pay rates and should have more more money made available to their sports than they do.





The priority for the community and for ratepayer expenditure is community sport facilities which enable thousands of residents to be active every week as identified in the Regional Sports Facility Strategy. Consultation regarding proposed enhancements has not been transparent or community-wide, evidence around decisions has not been provided, and the enhancements do not align with the Strategy or the current processes followed by sports for facility development. We support that a repair of some scale needs to be undertaken but require more detail of what is included in the \$36m is required and what scale of stadium is appropriate for the region now and into the future. We do not support the \$19m of enhancements which should be accounted for within the existing Asset Management Plan and/or via the Regional Facility Strategy process if sport-related. We feel strongly that there is a great need for an equitable approach to facility improvements and funding across sports.
