We should not be building big facilities for rugby and ignoring the thousands of other young sportsmen and sportswomen in the province who play other sports and struggle for money and facilities. TRC and NPDC need to be more equitable in their funding to all sports. Rugby has the highest profile in New Zealand, but many more

people play other sports than the number that play rugby. The Taranaki Rugby Union are more concerned with their status in Taranaki than they are with their own clubs and club competitions. Club sportsmen and sportswomen pay rates and should have more

more money made available to their sports than they do.
