

Register of Pecuniary and Other Specified Interests



Summary of annual returns as at 13 February 2023

The *Local Government (Pecuniary Interests) Amendment Act 2022* requires Council to publish a summary of Elected Member's Pecuniary Interests on its website. This is to provide transparency and to strengthen public trust and confidence in local government processes and decision making.

The summaries are an individual snapshot of members' interest for the previous 12 months.

In addition to the Register, elected members may make a declaration of any interest or conflicts during a meeting according to the requirements of the *Local Authorities (Members' Interest) Act 1968*. There are recorded in the minutes of the meeting, which are available on the Agendas page of our website.

How the Register works

Elected members are provided with a declaration form to complete annually, once returned, a summary of the information is collated by Council officers and published on our website. This Register summarises the information provided by elected members' in their annual declarations in relation to the requirements of the Act which includes the following:

1. Company directorship and controlling interest (section 54E(1)(a));
2. Interests (such as shares and bonds) in companies or business entities (sections 54E (1)(b) and (2));
3. Employment (section 54E (1)(c))
4. Interests in trusts (section 54E (1)(d))
5. Organisations and trusts seeking council funding (section 54E(1)e));
6. Organisations appointed to by virtue of being an Elected Member (section 54E(1)(f));
7. Real property (section 54E(1)(g) and (1)(h));
8. Overseas travel (section 54F(1)(a));
9. Gifts (section 54F(1)(b));
10. Payments for activities (section 54F(1)(c)).

Where a question is not displayed in the member's response, no declaration was made.
