How to use the bus

Catching your bus

- Stand on the footpath near the front of the designated bus stop. Some bus stops are used by more than one route, so as the bus approaches, check the route number and destination displayed on the front of the bus.
- Raise your arm as a signal to the driver that you want the bus to stop.

On the bus

For your own safety and comfort, as well as those around you, please:

- Do not smoke, eat, drink, vape or play loud music
- If the bus is busy, please offer your seat to someone who may need it more than you – for example someone who is older, pregnant or travelling with young children
- Relax and enjoy your ride!

Leaving the bus

- As you approach the stop where you want to get off, press the bell once.
- Before leaving the bus, please check you have all your belongings.

You don't need a Bee Card to take the bus, but it is cheaper when you have one.

Apply for a Bee Card online or pick one up from any of our retailers.

Tag on tag off

Bee Card is a tag on tag off ticketing system - when you board the bus, hold your card over the card reader to tag on. Wait for the beep and green screen, then you're ready to go.

When you've reached your destination, do the same again to tag off. It's important to tag off to ensure you are charged the correct fare.

Manage your Bee Card

Bee Cards need to be registered to a Bee Card account to enable the online top up function and to protect your balance if you lose your card. You can also manage multiple cards in one Bee Card account, ideal for families with multiple cards.
