## Nominations

Nominations for the above positions open on **Friday 19 July 2019** and must be made on the appropriate nomination paper available from the respective electoral officer.  
Completed nomination papers must be received by the respective electoral officer no later than **noon on Friday 16 August 2019**. Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 incl GST, payable by electronic bank transfer, eftpos, cash or cheque.  
Candidates are advised that if they are intending to submit a candidate profile

statement and photograph for including with voting documents sent to electors, these must be lodged at the same time as the nomination paper and nomination deposit.  
Taranaki District Health Board candidates must also submit a Conflict of Interest Statement with their nomination.  
More information on the nomination process is in the relevant candidate information handbook available online or in hardcopy.
